Geyser Peak Winery was founded in 1880 by Augustus Quitzow, one of Sonoma County's pioneer winemakers. Perched on a hillside across from Geyser Peak Mountain in the Alexander Valley, Geyser Peak is one of the most award-winning wineries in Sonoma County with awards including this year's International Wine & Spirit Competition's (IWSC) "Best US Wine Producer."

In addition to being winemaker for Geyser Peak, Groom is a winemaker and owner of Groom wines and vice president of winemaking & operations for Peak Wines International. Prior to this position, he was both senior white winemaker and senior red winemaker for Penfolds Wines in Australia. He is a frequent judge for numerous international wine shows and has been a guest speaker on the Queen Mary 2 and Seabourne cruise lines. He has also been a repeat guest on E! Television. His accolades include several "winemaker of the year" awards from such national publications as *San Francisco Chronicle*, *Los Angeles Times* and *Dallas Morning News*. *Food & Wine magazine* named Groom "One of 11 Visionaries to Change the World of Wine" while the IWSC named him "International Winemaker of the Year."
