**Gallery at The Brown Announces A Hot Brown Art Contest**  
*Artists Can Win a Chance to Showcase Art at The Brown Hotel's Art Gallery*

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (June 13, 2007) - -The famous Hot Brown sandwich has gained a lot of attention in featured stories on *The Travel Channel* and in *Saveur* magazine, but now local artists can win a chance to get some attention of their own by paying tribute to the open face turkey sandwich. Gallery at the Brown is holding a Hot Brown Art Contest. The winning artist will win a chance to showcase and sell his or her original art at the gallery. Gallery at The Brown manager Christian Trabue is accepting entries now through Wednesday, August 1 at the gallery located in the first floor of The Brown Hotel. The contest showcase will officially open with a public wine and cheese reception on Friday, August 3 from 6 to 8 p.m.

“Since 1926, people have loved this sandwich,” said Trabue. “We want to see what local artists can do with that passion.”

Any two-dimensional media will be accepted including photography, painting, drawing and collage. The piece must include an image of the Hot Brown Sandwich. For more details on entry requirements, contact Trabue at Gallery at The Brown.

“When we receive the entries, we will display them in the gallery until the contest ends,” added Trabue. “We welcome the public to come and tell us what they think of each piece.”

Gallery at The Brown features local artists quarterly to bring awareness to Louisville’s visual arts scene. It is located on the first-floor of The Brown Hotel. The gallery is open Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 9 p.m. and 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Admission is free.
